



Pueblo Regional Development Plan & County Code (Zoning Ordinance) Amendments Regarding Solar Energy Facilities

Please act now by sending an email by August 10, 2021!

Pueblo County is in the process of updating the zoning ordinance for Solar installations. In the current form it is too restrictive and detrimental to add sufficient renewables in Pueblo. We might not be able to reach Pueblo's goal of 100% renewables by 2035. It also restricts Sunny Pueblo from building more large solar farms required to mitigate climate change.

REOCA's intention is to ask for a delay of 60 days to allow updates that would be better for Pueblo. More time is needed to study and update the zoning ordinance. We ask you to make this request to the county to delay for 60 days by sending an email.
